Table Tennis: Sports Exchange leading up to the 2020 Tokyo Olympics

The Singapore Table Tennis Association (STTA) and Shimada City Shizuoka Prefecture Government signed the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) today at Shimada City to formalize the sports collaboration leading up to 2020 Tokyo Olympics.

The MOU is made based on STTA working with the Shimada City Shizuoka Prefecture Government as an international training camp site leading up to the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games. The STTA will be holding its pre-Olympics training sessions at the Shimada City in 2019 and 2020.
