SINGAPORE, 8 June 2017 –Counting down! Only 4 more days to the 23rd Southeast Asian Junior & Cadet Table Tennis Championships, which will be held at the Toa Payoh Sports Hall from Tuesday, 13 June to Friday, 16 June 2017.

Southeast Asia's best youth talents from Brunei Darussalam, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam and Singapore will come together to compete in the 23rd Southeast Asian Junior & Cadet Table Tennis Championship, which will be hosted by the Singapore Table Tennis Association (STTA) and sanctioned by the Southeast Asian Table Tennis Association (SEATTA). Singapore last held the Southeast Asian Junior & Cadet Table Tennis Championship in 2002.

The Southeast Asian Junior & Cadet Table Tennis Championship promises to capture the imaginations of sporting fans. The gold and silver medallists in this Championship team event will qualify for the junior team event in the Asian Junior Table Tennis Championship 2017, held from 29 June to 4 July 2017, in Asan, South Korea.
